Choral Scholarship

*An alto is sought to join the vocal quintet at St John's, Notting Hill in **May 2022**.*

St John's maintains a rich musical culture. A friendly choir of five choral scholars and an organ scholar work with the Director of Music in high-quality liturgical music. Instrumental musicians in residence enrich the worship at important feasts, and a new children's music programme is planned for 2022.

The choral scholarships at St John's typically attract young singers from London universities, and those beginning freelance singing careers in London.

SUMMARY OF THE ROLE

- Weekly Sunday morning mass & one Sunday evensong per month during university term time only (approx. 40 Sundays a year)
- Commitments outside term time include services during Holy Week and Easter, but *not* on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day.
- Varied repertoire, typically encompassing Renaissance polyphony, Viennese masses, 19th and 20th Century music, accompanied by our recently restored, grade II listed organ.
- Good sight-reading ability required, and confidence singing I-to-a-part
- £1500p.a. and very good fees for optional extra services
